Directions to Gloucester County Fire Academy: From Philadelphia (using Walt Whitman or Benjamin Franklin Bridge), follow 295 South (toward Delaware) to exit #18 Rts. 667 & 678 “Clarksboro, Paulsboro, Mt. Royal”. Once on this exit ramp, take the second right Rt. 678 “Mt. Royal – Clarksboro”. At the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Berkley Rd. (Rt. 678 East). Follow Rt. 678 East for 1⁹/₁₀ mi. to the 3rd traffic light. [The lights are as follows: 1st Lt. entrance to Rt. 295/130 North; 2nd Lt. Rt. 667 Cohawkin Rd.; 3rd Lt. Rt. 551 Kings Hwy.] At the third light, there is a “6 point” intersection; make a soft right turn onto County House Rd. Follow County House Rd. (over R.R. tracks) for ½ mi. to the Fire Academy on left.

This CLE is a continuation of “Transgender 101” from April 2018, which explored legal issues prevalent in the transgender community. However, attendance at that first installment is not mandatory in order to follow and understand this second segment.

Transgender 102 will review the terms “transgender” and “gender” in relation to sex, as well as what it is to be “transgender”. In addition, updates to the previous topics of Employment Discrimination will be explored.

The course will focus on healthcare issues in the transgender community including general medical needs, WPATH Standards of Care, Insurance issues, and the impact of the Affordable Care Act. Finally, issues related to Education and Public Accommodations will be explored, including Title IX Protection, “Bathroom Bills” and Anti-Crossdressing Ordinances.
